Bob Grassilli called the meeting to order at 4:06 PM.

(a) Update on recent conversations with SamTrans.

Doug Kim discussed the potential for expanding bus service to Sequoia High in SamTrans' perspective. Discussed history, including SCOOT, Route 61 and Route 295, which used to serve the school, but it was a long route that SamTrans discontinued four years ago and it now ends at the Caltrain Station in San Carlos. Parents have requested a consideration of re-establishing Route 295. What changed? More students from San Carlos are going to Sequoia now and parents support it and will market it as they did with Route 61. If it were to happen, the earliest would be 1/2018. City is very interested in making this happen. Doug will contact Sequoia for data and work with City staff and parent's groups.

Robert Porter provided updates on Arundel and Fields and Facilities Inventory (handed out inventory sheets). Arundel. The School District Board decided against a larger athletic field due to size, timing and synthetic turf. The Board is open to exploring other locations for a field.

Fields and Facilities. Amy and Robert looked at the current use of facilities and fields. Perhaps there is a way to make the use more efficient. Perhaps we could discuss partnering together to consider expanding Central, reconfiguring TL, or expanding the area near the tennis courts.
